Ephesians 3:14-21

Main Idea

Ask God to experience His love and life for His glory.

- Paul's Prayer and Praise:
- Paul prays that God _____ believers in their inner being
- So that Christ occupies the rightful place in their affections
- So that they will become strong enough to _____ know Jesus's love
- So that they become everything God created them to be
- Paul praises God for being able to do more than he can ask or imagine

Implications

- We need God's strength to _____ Jesus's love. We need to know Jesus's love to become who God made us to be.
- The only thing bigger than our prayers should be our praise.

Application

- Admit if we're not experiencing God's life and love. Confess if we haven't even been asking to.
- Use Paul's prayer as a model to ask God to experience His strength, love, and fullness in your life.
- Praise God even before you see the answers to your prayers. Praise God for what He's done and who He is.

Discussion

- What does it reveal about God that experiencing Jesus's love is a core part of His plan for growing us into who He wants us to be?
- Paul presents God's love, life, and power as an infinite frontier into which we are to press with our prayers and personal experience.
- What would your life look like if you did that?
- What would our church look like if we did that?
